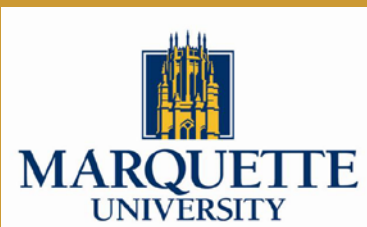

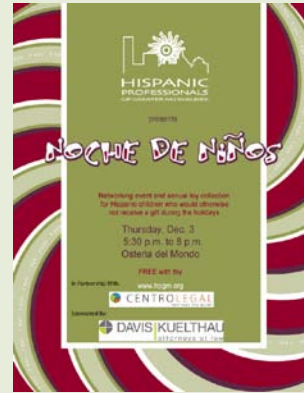

MILWAUKEE WOMEN ON BOARDS

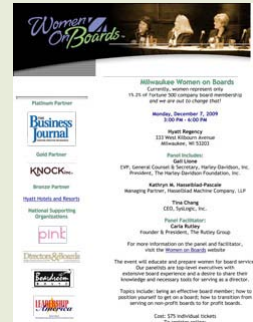
HPGM in partnership with Women on Boards brings you an event that will educate and prepare women for board service.

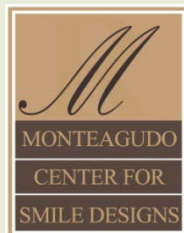
